

Four steps to measure your ring size:














1. Cut a thin strip of paper.
2. Wrap the paper strip around your finger. Make sure it is snug.
3. Mark with a pen where the two ends meet.
4. Measure the length of the paper up to the marked point.



Prior to printing, ensure that Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box. Measure the bar above. It must be exactly 1 inch or 30 mm long.

If you already have a ring that fits you can place your ring on to the round markers to find your correct ring size.
